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## KNOW YOUR DUE DATE

New Jersey requires a biennial emissions-only inspection for passenger vehicles. Commercial vehicles are required to pass mechanical defect and emissions testing. Check the sticker on your windshield to see when your vehicle is due.

## BE ALERT FOR SIGNS OF BRAKE TROUBLE
